

Antarctica Overview – 2011/12



General Description of Trips & Cruises

Classic Antarctic Cruise is a trip between 11 and 22 days, on board of a ship, visiting Antarctic Peninsula Area and even arriving to Antarctic Polar Circle.

It is all included on board (but the bar and optional activities, like kayaking, camping or diving), and there are two landings per day.

Here, there is some information about the trip and life on board:

About Antarctica:

What are we going to see:

People used to think that Antarctica is just a white big desert full of ice. However, there is so much to see: a rich wildlife, with different kind of penguins, seals, whales and sea birds of large size (like Albatross, Petrels or Fulmars).

Besides, it is also possible to see icebergs, enormous glaciers, mountains, hot waters, scientific bases, an old abandoned whaler, and the magnificent spectacle that the sea can show us.

What about the Climate:

Because of its polar location, Antarctica receive less solar radiation than any other place, so temperature is very low and the air is extremely dry. Anyway, during Antarctic Summer (December to March), in the Peninsula, temperatures are over 0°C (32°F). There is a big difference between temperature near the coast (average temperature of -5 °C/ 23°F) and into the continent (average temperature -50 °C/ -58°F).

What about Geography:

In Antarctica, there is 90% of ice on Earth, and 70% of fresh water in the world. However, in the continent, there is also land free of ice or snow. These areas are occupied by penguin rookeries and sea mammal colonies and recently, also by scientific bases.

Continent can be divided by two sections, separated by the Trans-Antarctic Mountains. East is the less visited area, forming by a big plateau, with 400 m thick of ice. West section is the area with lower surface, where Antarctic Peninsula is situated. We can find there more alpine glaciers, and the mountains which form the Antarctic Andes. It is an area with earthquake activity. In fact, some of the islands on the area were originally volcanoes.

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What about Wildlife:

Antarctic wildlife can be classified into three major groups:

- **Birds**, the most famous are Penguins, although there is also Albatross, Cormorants, Skuas, Gulls, Terns, etc.
- **Pinnipeds**, Otariids, like Fur Seals and proper Seals, like Elephant Seal, Weddell Seal, Crabeater Seal, Leopard Seal and Ross Seal.
- **Cetaceans**, with a great diversity of Whales (Blue Whale, Fin Whale, Minke, Humpback and Sperm Whale) and Dolphins (Orcas or Killer Whales).

In Antarctica also exists another animal, pretty much smaller but with singular importance: Krill.

Antarctica month to month:

Antarctic Season is from beginning of November to the end of March, Summer Time in the South Hemisphere. It's the moment of the year with more daylight and wildlife wakes up, after the long winter darkness. Each month shows different attractions.

- November – December (end of Spring & beginning of Summer)

Temperature is still low, so there is still many ice and icebergs floating on the sea. It's the mating time for Penguins, rebuilding their nests and seeking couple. Seals start to become visible on floating ice, and Elephant Seals and Fur Seals mark their territory. Pups of Crabeater Seals were born between September and November. The first big whales arrive to Antarctic Area to feed on Krill. Scientists, who live during all the year on Bases, welcome the first visitors of the Season.

- December – January (Summer)

It's the warmest season of the year. Days are long, with many hours of light. Bird eggs hatch and chicks were born. It is also possible to see pups of Fur Seals and Leopard Seals. This is a period with much activity in the Colonies.

- February – March (end of the summer)

To see icebergs, it is necessary to go further south. Chicks of Penguins start to learn how to dive. There is less snow on the coast, so it allows a better approach to the penguin colonies. Adult Penguins molt their feathers and young ones go to the sea. There is a big concentration of Fur Seals. March is the best moment for Whale watching.

About the Trip:

How is life on board?

Amenities on board are the same that we can find in a hotel. The way of dress is casual. Temperature inside of the ship is comfortable. All meals are included, as well as coffee service, available all day. On this kind of Expedition Cruises, the passenger number is between 50 and 120 people.

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It is recommended to bring any medications for seasickness, especially during the crossing of Drake Passage, where the sea generally is rough.

How long does it take to cross Drake Passage?

Crossing Drake Passage takes around 2 days. Sometimes, it can be more or a little less than that. It depends on weather conditions.

During this crossing, there is no land, consequently, no landings. This is time enough for Conference and lectures about Polar-themes: Ice, Antarctic Treaty, Geomorphology of the continent, History of Great Explorers (Scott, Amundsen, Shackleton).

Are there any landing?

Once we arrived to Antarctic Area, there are two daily landings provided, as long as weather conditions allow it.

What do I have to bring?

- Sunglasses with UV filter
- Binoculars
- Thermal clothing
- Factor 60 sunblock
- Gloves & hat
- Parka
- Swimsuit
- Hiking shoes
- Waterproof pants
- Rubber boots

What do I have to wear?

Inside the boat, we wear we wear the same clothe as in Ushuaia. During landings, don't forget hats, gloves, rubber boots, waterproof pants and a parka.

What is it included?

All meals on board are included, guides, printed guide, conferences, rubber boots. Sometimes, drinks during lunch and dinner, parka and access to sauna and gym.

Are we going to get off at the bases?

We get off at the bases, as well as weather condition allows us. It is possible to visit some of them and you can even stamp your passport.

Is it possible to buy gifts?

Most of the ships have got a Souvenir Store. In some bases, like the British Port Lockroy (today a Museum) sells Antarctic souvenirs and it also works as a Post Office. You can send a postcard from Antarctica!

Itinerary:

Departing from Ushuaia Harbor, the cruise crosses Drake Passage to Elephant Island. From there, it visits South Shetland Islands, and then Antarctic Peninsula, to Parallel 60° South. From that point, the ship comes back to Ushuaia Harbor. Normally, the trip includes 2 landings per day, if weather conditions are available.
