### Alpine ski Programms

**Introduction:** alpine skiing in Tierra del Fuego began in the decade of the '50s, with the help of the pioneers of the Club Andino Ushuaia, with precarious means of drag, which were assembled by hand in the upper Martial Glacier. Since then, everything has changed considerably, and now has two modern ski centers, which make it possible to practice all disciplines of skiing. The snow conditions due to the low thermal gradient of the island and the long season (June to October) of Tierra del Fuego are an ideal place to discover.

**Cerro Castor** is the main ski center of Tierra del Fuego, with media art, and with a high ratio of media / tracks (4 mainstream media and 19 + tracks), is one of the safest Resort and comfortable in the country.

**Winter Center Martial:** A small resort, located on the outskirts of the city. It has a double chairlift, a main track, a beginner, and three secondary tracks. It is a center frequented by youngsters and children from Ushuaia, and perhaps the best place for beginners.



### Beginner Ski Week

**Place:** Cerro Castor & Winter Martial Center

**Activities:** Alpine Ski & Cross Country Skiing introduction

**Duration:** 8 days & 4 days (sat / sat or weakday) Regular minimum 2 pax

**Ski Tierra Mayor Valley:** Tierra Mayor Valley is one of the coldest areas of the Big Island, there is Cerro Castor Ski Track Fund White March of 21 km long. Ideal for a day of walking in snow, visiting various winter resorts.



**Francisco Jerman Track:** The Club Andino Ushuaia track, has his back to the city, just 3 km is accredited by the International Ski Federation, and is the best track for those who enjoy this sport.

We take time to enjoy Lapataia Bay and the impressive landscape that surrounds us and then, in our vehicle to go to Lake Roca and do a little walk along its coasts. <p><b>Description:</b> A half day excursion, ideal to combine with another in the afternoon, as the navigation of the Beagle Channel.</p> <p>Departure from the hotel toward Tierra Mayor Valley, in this great valley after crossing from snow sleds pulled by Huskies, after crossing the valley we enter the woods on an old path of loggers in the midst of this centennial forest of Lenga arrived at the shelter the Logger (small log cabin heated with wood). We said goodbye to the Huskies and our guide will help to put on snowshoes (without which we could not walk due to the thickness of the snow that normally comes with the meter), Goal: The cascade of Ice Alvear and the viewpoint of the Valley, the return to the refuge is faster and more fun because it is downhill and ends in the refuge of the Logger, the shelter re-energize with a hot chocolate.</p> <p>from the refuge of the logger back to the Tierra Mayor Valley walking shoe ..</p>



We crossed the mountains by the Garibaldi Pass, accessing the Lago Fagnano footprint by an old logger, skirted the lake to reach a vantage point where make one stop and take a snack. We returned to Tierra Mayor Valley, where tasting lunch and have time for optional activities such as: Snow cats, sledges pulled by huskies, cross country skiing and ice skating, or simply contemplate the great Valle Nevado from the warm lodge. back to Ushuaia.</p>

<b>Itinerary:</b> Departure from the hotel 9:30 am - Transfer to the waterfall in the Valley of Tierra Mayor - Climbing and lunch in the place - Trekking with snowshoes through the woods to the Complex Cerro Castor - Return to the city - Expected time of arrival 05:00 pm.	
<b>Description:</b> Departure from the hotel toward the Tierra Mayor Valley, our musher instructor welcomes us giving us an introductory talk to the world of sled dogs and visiting the farm. Then started driving instruction sled, armed with knowledge of techniques and management thereof. We put harnesses on dogs, hooked to the sled, and the cry of SIGA! Start our experience. This adventure is a dogsled trip powerful yet fun! As we move our caravan of sleds out into the snowy valley, culminating in Base Camp I, where calories and will reimburse the first chance to meet some armed techniques and experience the magic igloos white silence ..... After recovering calories, dogs get ready again and returned to Earth Mayor. <b>Difficulty:</b> moderate, to participate passengers should have a good health, you have to like dogs, and possess a spirit of teamwork. Go into sled dogs is an activity comparable to the ski bottom, so you have to be in reasonably good physical shape.

The return is by choice.
